



WANT TO RUN FOR NOMINATING COMMITTEE?

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW.

Nominating committee information is now available for the 2022 DCREMC election. Information and the petition can be downloaded from our website dcremc.com/governance. Interested member-consumers can also call the DCREMC office and request a packet as well.

The nominating committee will also be present at the annual meeting to assist the DCREMC attorney in verifying the election results.

**Nominating committee members are compensated \$100 for attending each committee meeting and receive reimbursement for necessary travel.*

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Candidates must be a DCREMC member in good standing.
2. Candidates must reside (for at least 8 months of the calendar year) in the geographical district up for election, use electric energy provided by DCREMC and be nominated by the board of directors or complete a petition with at least 50 unique member signatures.

WHEN DO BOARD ELECTIONS OCCUR

The election process for DCREMC begins prior to the annual meeting. Only those member-consumers who have completed the necessary requirements to run for candidacy will be placed on the ballot. During the election period, which is the month leading up to the annual meeting, members vote electronically or by mail. The ballots are tabulated, and results are announced at the annual meeting.

WHAT ARE THE DUTIES OF THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE?

1. To select the best candidates to run for directorship of DCREMC who exhibit leadership qualities, promotes the ideals of local ownership and control consistent with cooperative principles, and will support and defend the cooperative.
2. Maintain the cooperative's democratic process by bringing forth at least one qualified director candidate (in each applicable district) for the annual election.
3. Communicate expectations and qualifications to potential director candidates.
4. Assist the DCREMC attorney in verifying the election results at the annual meeting.

WHAT IS THE EXPECTED TIME COMMITMENT?

DCREMC's nominating committee meets at least two times a year in preparation for the annual election of candidates. During the meetings, the committee will discuss potential candidates, review and approve the director candidates for the annual election. The nominating committee is responsible for speaking with potential member candidates and securing election candidates outside of those meetings.
